## **Verify Partner Profile**

**Overview:** Verify a partner organization's profile. An organization's profile must be verified by a UN agency user in order for the partner's application to be selected for to establish a potential partnership.

Once the shield is green it implies the organization profile has been verified and UN organization can proceed in selecting this organization for partnerships. Organization with a red shield have failed the verification exercise and will not be able to be selected as a partner of any UN organization.
